LEED is a third-party certification program and the nationally accepted benchmark for the design, construction, and operation of high performance green buildings. LEED promotes a whole-building approach to sustainability by recognizing performance in five key areas of human and environmental health: sustainable site development, water savings, energy efficiency, materials selection, and indoor environmental quality.



Ultra High Efficiency

This building utilizes the highest efficient equipment manufactured by Aeon. The 64,000 square-foot administration building's climate control system consists of four evaporative condensing package air handling units, with a variable air volume, hot water reheat system.

With over 50 zones in the building, every square inch remains at a comfortable temperature while not wasting energy in unneeded spaces.

With the amount of outside air needed to achieve a LEED status, each unit is equipped with a heat recovery wheel that preconditions air prior to distributing it throughout the building, thus maximizing the efficiency of the equipment.
